

# SHOESHINERS

Volunteer Check-In for Beautification Volunteers is 5:00pm.

We will provide everything needed for the volunteers who are doing shoeshine. We will have shoeshine boxes for our Honored Guests to rest their shoes on and complete shoeshine kits.

Shoeshine dress code needs to be one of the following: long dress pants and dress shirt, tux, suit & tie, jumpsuit, or a long dress calf to floor length. Volunteers will be sitting on the ground in front of the Honored Guests and with others standing behind them.

Make sure to ask before polishing and if the shoes can be polished.

Shoeshining procedure:

- 1) Clean the dust/dirt off the shoes with a horsehair shine brush with a back-and-forth motion. Use a clean towel to get the rest of the dust or dirt if needed.
- 2) Apply a small amount of shoeshine polish (brown or black) using your shoeshine brush in circular motions. You can always add more polish if needed. Brush until there are no streak marks.
- 3) Cover the shoe evenly with polish.
- 4) Wipe off any excess polish or wax using a towel.
- 5) Take the dry cloth and buff the shoe until you achieve the desired result.

Some of our Honored Guests may not have shoes that really need buffing. We still want them to have an experience with our Beautification Team. Simply, take your cloth and slowly “buff” their shoes. Even this small act can help an Honored Guest feel special and pampered.

Your Team Lead will release you after all Honored Guests are taken care of and all the station areas are clean. Plan on leaving between 6:30pm-7:00pm. If you have any questions, please feel free to ask.
